

A.N. MYER SCHOOL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

1. Chair's Welcome: Christina welcomed everyone and thanked them for attending.

2. Principal's Report:

- Feedback re: Myer Alumni 60th Reunion:
 - BBQ: BBQ will hopefully break even. Students did not purchase as much food as was expected. Sales were mostly beverages. Lots of food left-over; some of the excess food was used at the Cave Springs event and some is still in the freezer.
 - Johanna will meet with Helga Campbell this week to discuss the event and review funds raised.

- New MacBain Scholarships: John MacBain has offered 7 scholarships in Niagara Falls to students graduating this year (3 to Myer, 1 to Stamford, 1 to Westlane, 1 to St. Paul, and 1 to St. Mike's). The scholarships will go to students that are on the honour roll, are involved in his/her community, show entrepreneurship, and show good character. The scholarships could include full undergraduate tuition for four years. The details are to be determined by the beginning of 2018. Students will be nominated based on meeting predetermined criteria. Ten Myer students will be nominated and interviews will follow.

- **Matched Donations:** John MacBain has also offered to match any donations to A. N. Myer up to \$20,000. Monies raised will be used to purchase a scoreboard for the football field.
