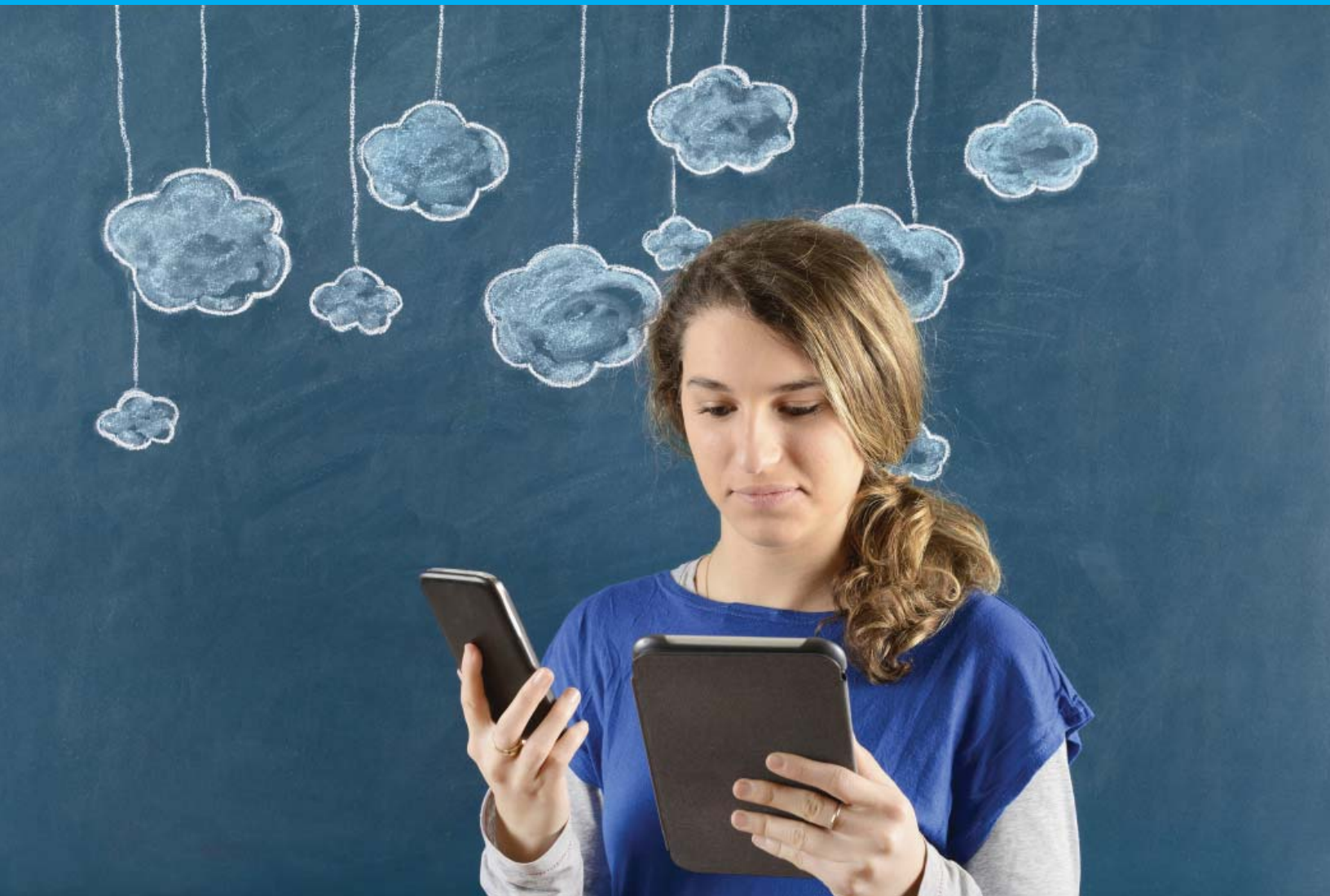

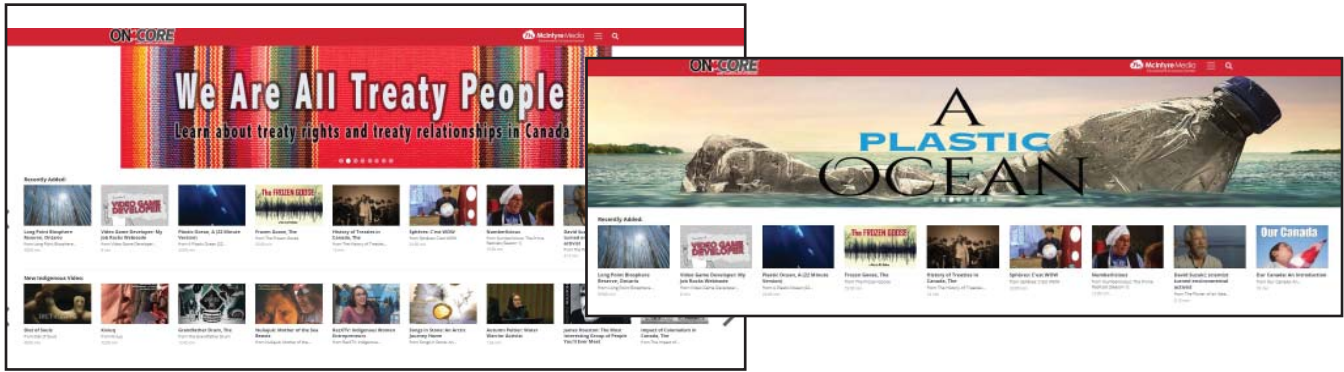

The rotating banner and sliders on the landing page feature **new additions**:

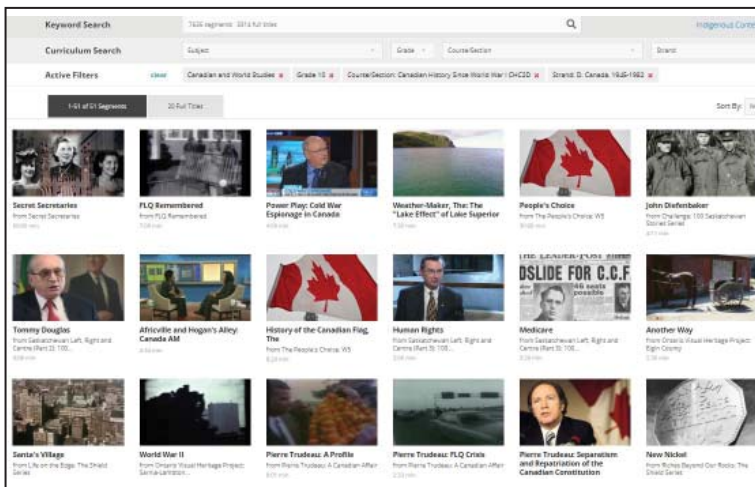


The **search icon** takes you to the home page:



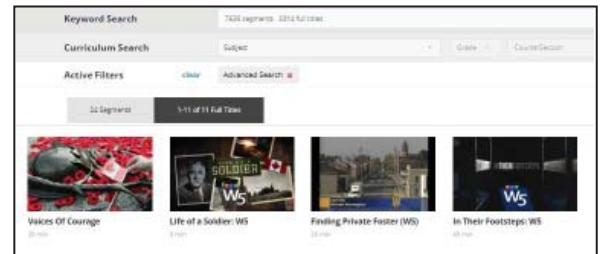
Segments and titles are correlated to the **Ontario Curriculum, K-12, all subjects**, and are searchable by **subject, grade, course and strand**. In the Curriculum search bar, select Subject, then Grade, then Course/Section, then Strand from the drop-down lists.

*Example – Canadian and World Studies, Grade 10, Canadian History Since World War I CHC2D, D. Canada, 1945-1982*

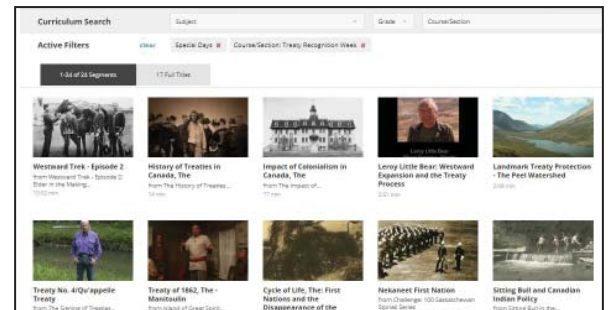


For **holidays**, pick **“Special Days”** from the subject list; skip Grade; choose from the Course/Section list:

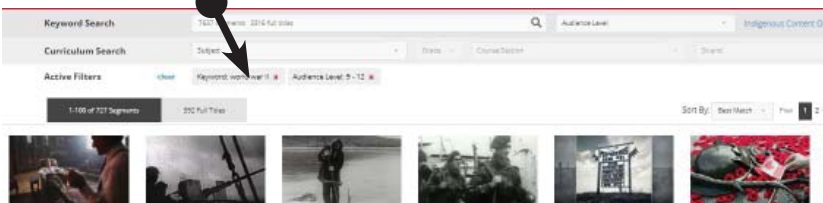

“If you do a **keyword search**, then select an **audience level**, you can find videos suitable for the students you are teaching.”

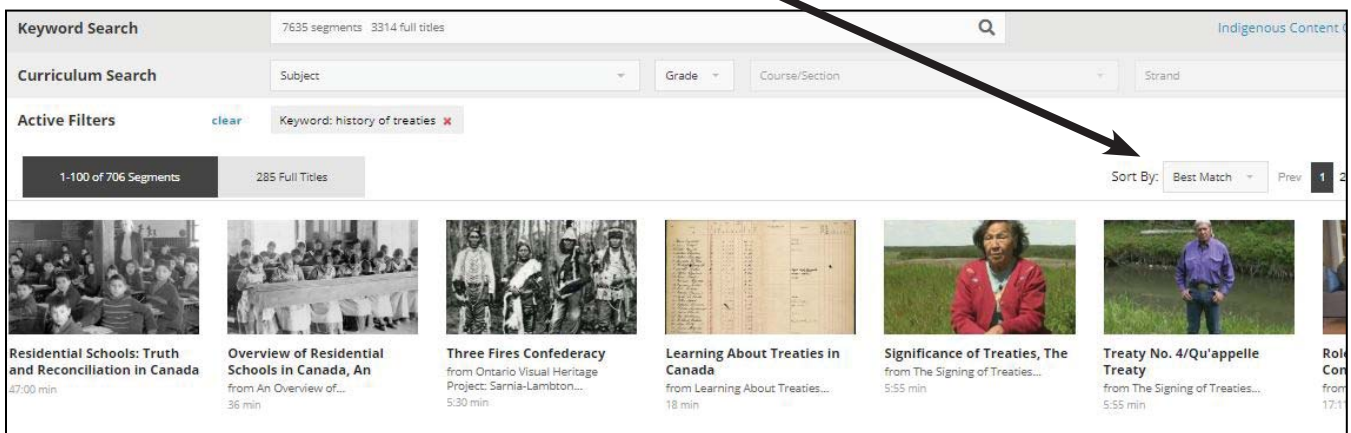
**Example:** Enter Keyword Turtles, click the search icon, then select an audience level

To save segments or titles for future use, you can create playlists:

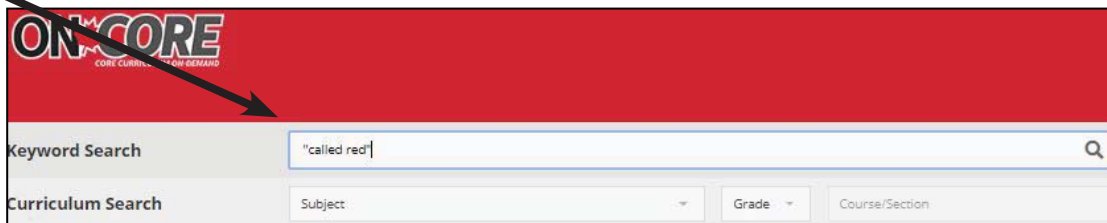
- To create a custom playlist, you must create an account for yourself - simply log out and click “Sign Up” on the Log-in page and fill in the form that pops up. When you get an acknowledging e-mail from us, log in to your personal account.
- To save a video segment or title, click on “add to ‘My Lists’ ” beside the title in the view window and follow the steps.



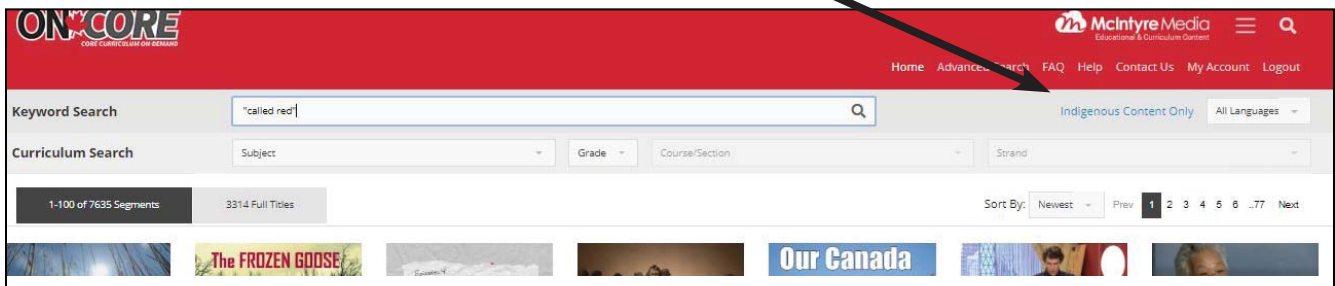
Keyword searches return results sorted by ‘Best Match’ or they can be resorted alphabetically.



Place “quotes” around a phrase in a keyword search to help find specific titles or topics:



On any page, you can select the filter “Indigenous content only”; over 10% of the content is by or about Canadian Indigenous peoples.
